


SOFT PASTEL LANDSCAPES

Techniques:



Blending:

Lay down 2 areas of different colour next to each other then use a pastel tool or your fingers to smudge the colours together. This technique is great for backgrounds to give you a thin layer of pastel with a smooth blend of colour.



Stippling:


Make short brisk strokes or dots over your paper with the edge of your pastel to create texture. Try adding a few different colours to create tonal value and vibrancy.



Hatching / Cross Hatching:

Use the edge of your pastel to create a series of fine lines spaced closely together. This technique is used for shading and texture. You can apply more lines over the first set but in a different direction to add depth. Try changing colours for a textured blend.
